The West Virginia Whistle-blower Law protects public employees against discharge, discrimination, or retaliation when they, in good faith, report any instances of

WASTE	WRONGDOING
Substantial abuse, misuse, destruction, or loss of public funds or resources designed to protect the public interest	Non-technical violations of any statute, regulation, ordinance, or code of ethics

W. Va. Code § 6C-1-1
